Range Information for New Shooters:

- a. Safety is our paramount concern. Please be aware of our range rules as they are posted and respect them. Failure to do so could result in ejection from the shooting program.
- b. Range attire should be appropriate for the activity. Please no open toed shoes, heels, or v-neck shirts. Jeans are allowed.
- c. Program parking will be designated upon arrival, but will generally be along the gravel road outside the fence. Guns left in vehicles must be cased.
- d. 12 Gauge shotguns only, unless specified otherwise for specific events. DO NOT bring personal ammunition to the range. CYCoP supplies shells for all events.
- e. Eye and ear protection is required for everyone on the firing line. If you do not have your own, the club will provide them.
- f. Upon arrival, please sign in asap with the Cashier so that you can be squaded accordingly. New shooters to the club will be supervised for the first few rounds.
- g. If you do hold certifications (such as ATA or CYCoP cards) please bring them.
- h. Safety briefs take place before shooting commences *every day*. As a new shooter it is especially important you are present for this so you can learn the facility and safety requirements.
